4. Resolution Scheduling Public Hearing on Administrative Contracts

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:11-11 requires boards of education to provide at least 30 days' notice to the public prior to taking action regarding the renegotiation, extension, amendment, or alteration of an employment contract with the Superintendent of Schools, Assistant Superintendent of Schools, or School Business Administrator; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:11-11 also requires boards of education to hold a public hearing regarding any such proposed action and provide at least 10 days' public notice of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education will consider the renegotiation, extension, amendment, or alteration of the Board's employment contracts with Michael Harvier, Business Administrator/Board Secretary following a public hearing to be held on January 8, 2008 commencing at 8:00PM in Metuchen New Jersey at Metuchen High School. .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that notice of the Board's proposed action and notice of the hearing regarding such proposed action shall be provided through publication in the Board's official newspapers and posted in locations where public notices are regularly posted by the Board no later than 30 days prior to January 23, 2008.
