

DISTRICT GOAL FOR 2010 – 2011 SCHOOL YEARS

Goal #1: Revision and redesign of the staff evaluation process and protocol

Goal Statement: The purpose of assessment of teaching practice is to promote quality instruction that aligns with district goals and objectives. The process will be designed to promote the kind of professional learning that allows educators to continually grow in both knowledge and skill as well as acquire new techniques to improve instructional practices and methods.

DISTRICT GOALS FOR 2010 – 2011 SCHOOL YEARS

Goal #2: Improving Consistency of Placement/Grading

Goal Statement: Work with a committee of teachers, administrators, guidance personnel, special services personnel, all subject area supervisors and high school students to review current grading practices at Moss, Campbell, Edgar and Metuchen High Schools to ensure consistency. Evaluate the current practice of waiving students into accelerated and honors classes at Edgar and MHS in order to develop protocols for implementation in the 2011/2012 school year.

Goal #3: Enhancing the Metuchen High School Schedule

Goal Statement: Work with a committee of teacher representatives from each department, all subject area supervisors, building-level administrators, guidance director and high school students to evaluate the high school schedule with regard to flexibility for allowing enhancements of programs such as additional course offerings or modifications of course offerings to begin with the 2010/2011 school year and continue through the 2011/2012 school year.
