Student Attendance – A Reminder

Please review the below-listed student attendance procedures and information:

- Call the Main Office (732-321-8743), the Attendance Office (x8500), or the Nurse's Office (x8747) on the morning of the absence. If a phone call is not received, your child's absence will be considered "unexcused" and he/she will be considered truant. An excused absence is defined as illness/injury, religious holidays as designated by the state, death in the family, extreme emergencies, quarantine, or authorization by school officials (court appearances, driving test, college visits, etc.). Please note that documentation may be required.
- Call any of the above numbers when your child is tardy to school. Running late and/or oversleeping are not considered excused tardies.
- Call any of the above numbers or submit a written note one day in advance to request an early dismissal. The morning of the early dismissal the office staff will give your child a written pass that will allow them to leave class.

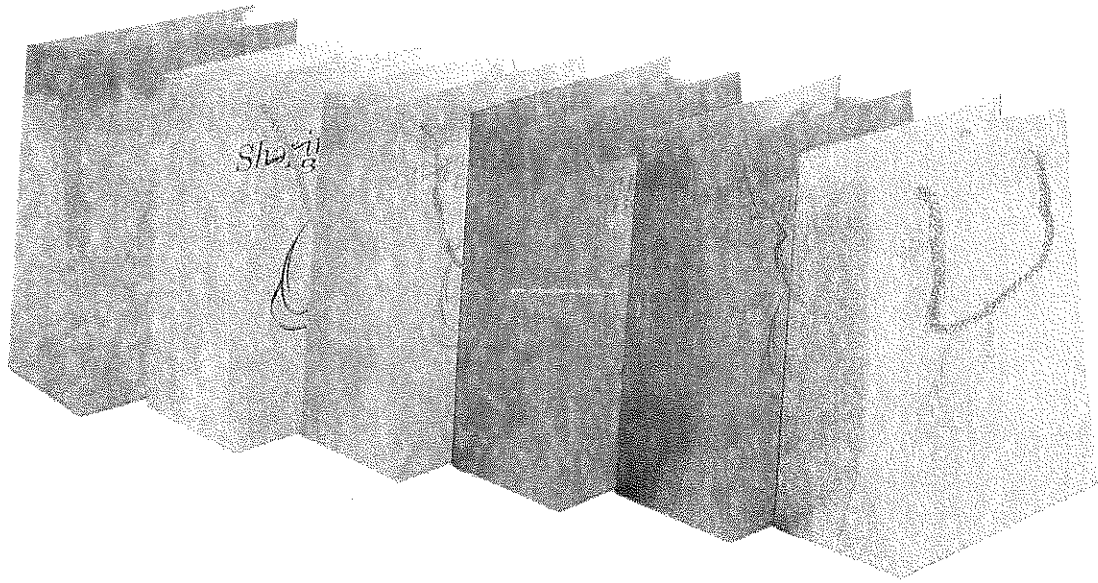
It is important to note that prolonged or repeated absences and/or tardies, excused or unexcused, from school or from class, deprive the student of experiences essential to learning. Additionally, excessive absences and/or tardies may result in loss of credit in a course or courses. It is also important to note that your child's attendance record will appear on their transcript which is sent when applying to colleges.

If there are ongoing health problems or personal matters that are causing frequent absences or tardies, please contact Vice Principal Susan La Fauci, your child's guidance counselor, or the nurse to discuss the matter.
